The EqPay4all Project

The "EqPay4All" project is funded by the Erasmus+ programme of the European Union in the field of Youth. Its aim is to raise awareness of gender pay gaps in the labour market. To achieve this, the project illuminates stereotypes that perpetuate inequalities and reinforce unjust structures. It also emphasises empowering women to use their voices confidently and advocate for themselves in professional settings.



The Consortium

The consortium is formed by different organisations from all over Europe: Non-governmental organisation, technical partners, VET centers and women associations join forces to tackle the gender pay gap.

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The Virtual Think Tank platform

We have established a Virtual Think Tank (VTT) platform to provide access to information on the gender pay gap and help users acquire new skills and competencies to address this issue. The platform will include

- the e-learning components (as described above)
- a certificate
- a map of bodies
- a network of mentors

Our Progress

So far, the design and development of the platform have progressed smoothly and remain on schedule. This includes designing and implementing the landing page, as well as translating key features and functions into the five languages of the consortium partners. While still under construction, the Virtual Think Tank has been designed to include digitised webinar content in all consortium languages. Currently, English content—such as courses, forums, chatrooms, quizzes, and certificate generation—has been implemented. The next phase of the project will involve integrating translations of this content into the system.
